

## **Celebration**

We celebrate this day to remember that Prophet Muhammed chose Hazrat Ali as his successor at Gadhir-e-Khumm. This occasion symbolises the Habillah (the chain of imamat or the next leader). Eid-e-Milad and Eid-al-Gadhir are two names for marking the same day, for two different reasons.

**Eid-e-Milad** or **Eid-e-Milad-un-Nabi** - This name is used to mark the Prophet's birth and death anniversary.

**Eid-al-Gadhir** - This name is used to mark the handing over of the spiritual rein to Hazrat Ali at Gadhir-e-Khumm. (The route between Syria and Yemen)
